## The Basics - *use what you already have*

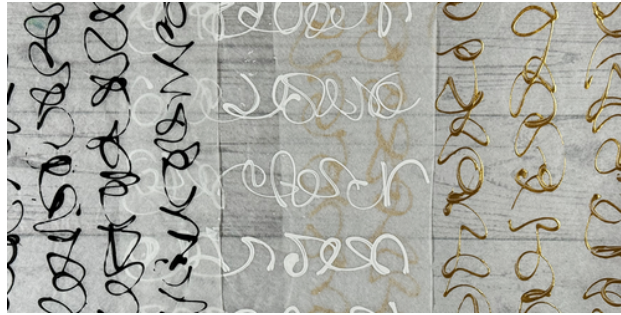
- Papers to create collage papers - choose 2+
  - Drawing paper
  - Copy paper 28 lb, 24 lb also fine
  - Bristol paper, Mixed Media, Water Color
  - Old books, maps, dictionaries, etc
  - Natural kraft paper (also buy from hardware store on a roll where its called "painter paper")
  - Homemade water color paper
  - Rice Paper
  - Tissue paper (any of these will work, choose one type)
    - Acid free
    - Spectra Art Tissue - white
    - Cheap gift grade from drug store (what I use most often)
- Sketchbook - to create contrast collages on Days 8 & 9
  - Favorites - Ranger Dylusions, Canson Mixed Media, or any sketchbook with fairly heavy paper
  - Alternative - use heavy weight paper like Bristol, Water Color or Mixed Media papers (links above)
- Brushes
  - Princeton - set of six OR 1" flat and round
- Acrylic Paint
  - **Choose just two primaries - blue and yellow, or yellow and red - You will make all your papers using just two colors.**
  - There will be a Live Lesson on Day 2 to show you how to mix many colors from your 2 primaries
  - Also white, black, and possibly gold or silver
  - Favorite brands - Nova, Golden, and Liquitex (or this one)
- Glue
  - Matte or gloss medium, Liquitex or Golden (light weight papers)
  - Gel medium, Liquitex Matte or Golden Gloss (heavier weight papers)
  - OR Yes Paste, glue stick, or anything you like to use
- Princeton Catalyst Wedge or old credit card
- Scissors and X-acto Knife - #11 blade

## ○ Paper #1 - Intentions / Asemic Writing

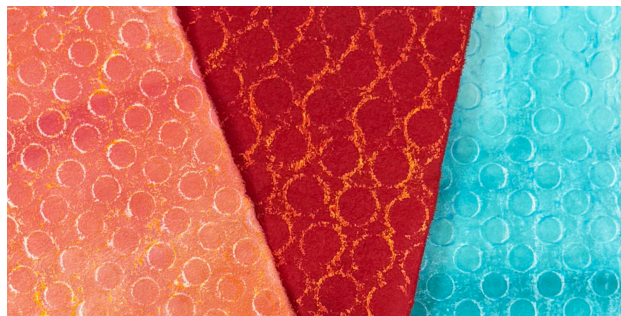
January 1



- Any type of tissue, drawing or copy paper (links previous page)
- Choose at least ONE black and/or white pen
  - [Sakura Brush Pens](#), 3 pack
  - [Staedtler Pigment Liner](#), set of 4 tip sizes
  - [Uni-Ball Signo](#) - white, silver, gold
  - [Faber-Castell Pit Big Brush Pen](#)
- [Paint bottles with fine tip](#) or [Needle squeeze bottle](#) (optional)

## ○ Paper #2 - Crayon Resist

January 3

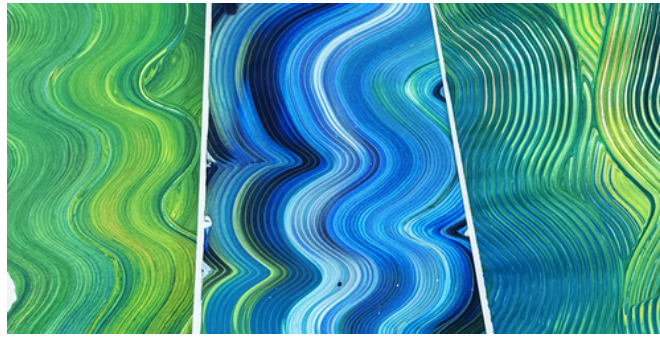


- Crayons, choose one type (white most versatile)
  - [White Crayola Crayons](#)
  - [Crayola Crayons](#), variety box
  - [Bees Wax Crayons](#)
- Choose one or more papers:
  - [Rice Paper](#), [Drawing paper](#) 80 lbs, or [Copy paper](#)
- [Wide flat brush](#) 2" or 1"
- [Mister spray bottle](#)
- [Scotch Delicate surface tape](#)
- Things with raised surfaces: stencils, coasters, embossing packets
- Acrylic paint using 2 primaries (color lesson on Day 2)
- [Palette paper](#) or plastic plate to mix paint on



### ○ Paper #3 - Scrape

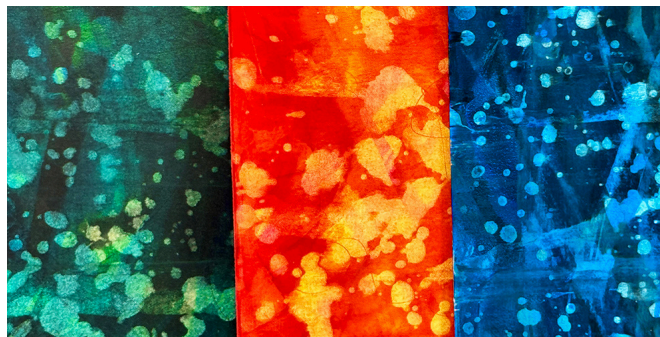
January 4



- Choose one or more heavier weight paper:
  - Watercolor hot press, 140 lbs
  - Mixed Media, 184 lbs
  - Sketch, 75 lbs
- Items to scrape with - search around your home!
  - Small combs, Bathroom scraper
  - Palette knife, Catalyst texturing wedge, old credit card
  - Trowel
- Acrylic paint, condiment bottle (optional)
- Palette paper or plastic plate/surface to mix paint

### ○ Paper #4 - Water Resist

January 4

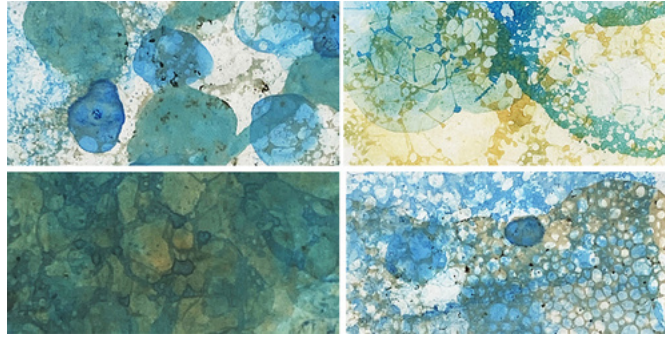


- Choose one or more heavier weight papers:
  - Watercolor hot press, 140 lbs
  - Mixed Media, 184 lbs or 104 lbs
  - Bristol
- Catalyst wedge, old credit card/room key
- Ranger craft mat, or plastic surface like wax paper
- Acrylic paint



## ○ Paper #5 - Bubble

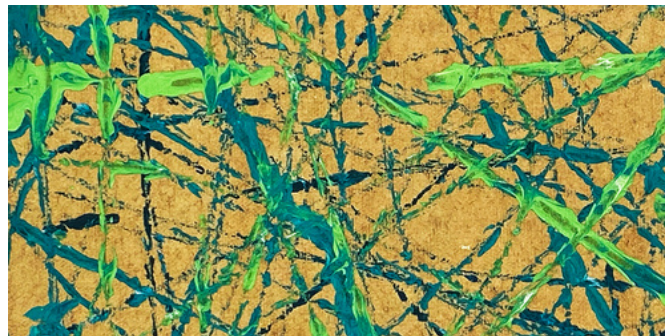
January 6



- Dishwashing liquid
- Choose one or more types of paper:
  - Watercolor paper hot press 140 lbs
  - Rice paper
  - Homemade water color paper
  - Copy paper
  - Tea bag paper from Jane Monteith
- Paper straws
- Shallow plastic cups
- Old thin sock

## ○ Paper #6 - Marbles

January 6



- Plastic surface to create papers on - choose ONE
  - Ranger nonstick craft mat (LOVE this product)
  - Plastic file folders
  - Parchment paper
  - Plastic shower curtain
- Spray bottle filled with water
- Acrylic paint, full strength
- Drawing, Copy, Rice paper, and/or book pages
